



NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS

TAX SALE

All properties with outstanding balances are subject to the annual tax sale process, wherein payment collection is enforced by a lien being placed on the property. To avoid inclusion in the tax sale, customers are strongly encouraged to bring there accounts current as soon as possible.

A lien is a legal right or claim against a property. It allows the creditor to seize or claim the property if the debt is unpaid within the delegated timeframe.

The New Jersey State Tax Law requires the tax collector to create the tax sale list 50 days prior to the sale. All charges on that list together with cost of sale must be paid in order to stay out of the sale.
